

YOUTH PASTOR/DIRECTOR (Part Time)

Position Purpose:

The Community Church, located in Novato, CA, is seeking a part-time Youth Pastor/Director. The Youth Pastor/Director will be responsible for the leadership and coordination of all youth programs, from Middle School to High School. They will also provide direction and vision to develop and improve the Youth Ministry. This candidate will work under the supervision of the Senior Pastor.

The goal of the Youth Pastor/Director at The Community Church is to make disciples of our youth by helping them grow in their faith and relationship with Jesus Christ, so that they may learn to live in His love, as they learn to live out His love in their lives.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Provide oversight of all students and volunteers. Assure ministry maintains a balanced program of spiritual, physical, personal and social growth and development by securing and creating age-appropriate resources.
- 2. Train, develop and supervise volunteers for the Youth Ministry, including finding resources to train volunteers to be effective and prepared.
- 3. Take care of all necessary administrative duties for the Youth ministry (ie. Budget, marketing, social media)
- 4. Plan, coordinate, and implement events and programs for the youth consistent with the vision and growth of the church (ie. Retreats, seasonal events, outings, etc.).
- 5. Assist the Senior Pastor/Leadership Team in responding to the needs of the youth and their families.
- 6. Connect and communicate with parents to offer formal and informal support, provide necessary updates, training, discipleship, and congregational support.
- 7. Teach, lead, and supervise the youth to grow in their faith, including mentoring and meeting students outside of Friday/Sunday meetings.
- 8. Occasional preaching, as scheduled with the Senior Pastor/Leadership Team.
- 9. Other duties as assigned by the Senior Pastor or Leadership Team.

Preferred Knowledge and Experience:

- Bachelor/Seminary/certificate degree with a concentration in Youth Ministry preferred
- Strong Biblical Knowledge and ability to communicate it to all ages
- Demonstrates experience in developing and managing creative and engaging ministry programs for the youth
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Comfortable with use of social media, texting, and apps to communicate and connect with members
- Skilled in the use of computer office software applications such as Word, Excel, and PowerPoint
